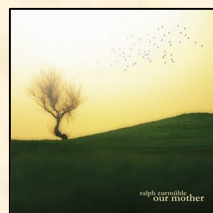
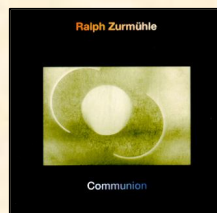
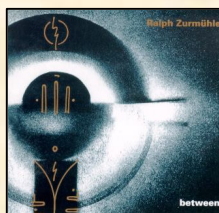

For more than twenty years Ralph has been offering solo piano concerts in Europe and the United States, performing mostly his own compositions. Since 1986 he has scored music for film, TV, theatre and multimedia projects. Some of these projects are:

- *All Secrets*, an award-winning feature film (Edinburgh, 2008)
- *L'horitzó*, multimedia project (Metrònom, Barcelona y Bienal Internacional de Arte Contemporáneo, Almería, Spain)
- *Norró*, documentary for Spanish TV (La2)
- Silent films "*New music for classic silent Films*" (Valencian Institute of Modern Art, Valencia, Spain)

Ralph has published four CDs with his own solo piano compositions, each of which has received international critical acclaim. His most recent album "eQuinox", produced by Hearts of Space Records (New York) was released in June 2011.



Ralph Zurmühle, Swiss composer and pianist, discovered his natural talent for the piano at the early age of five. His career began as auto-didactic and his first pieces were composed by the age of ten. He then fostered his talent over decades with jazz and classical music studies in Zurich and Liechtenstein. Ralph arrived to Barcelona in 1999, where he lived for ten years. He then moved to Tucson, Arizona (EEUU). In March 2011 he returned to Spain and presently resides in the southern province of Cadiz.
